This book addresses knowledge gaps in RARP in 3 key sections: 1) Step-by-step approach including multiple technique options and innovations, 2) Patient selection, safety, outcomes, and 3) Preparing the patient for surgery. The order is more based upon knowledge priority rather than a chronologic sequence in which part 3 would go first. Part two allows more summary and commentary on evidence and part three allows some creative content that is otherwise hard to find in one place—medical evaluations, imaging, clinical trials, patient education, etc. This textbook emphasizes content for the advanced skills surgeon in that multiple techniques are presented as well as state of the art evidence. The learning curve is addressed and the authors clarify how this text is useful for learners. The caveat is that they should be careful in patient selection and stick with what their mentors are showing them. With experience, they can then branch out into the many techniques presented here. Robot-Assisted Radical Prostatectomy: Beyond the Learning Curve will also have cross-over appeal for surgical assistants, physician assistants, nurses, and anyone else involved in the surgical care of prostate cancer.

In the writings of Philostratus (ca. 170-ca. 250 CE), the renaissance of Greek

literature in the second century CE reached its height. His *Life of Apollonius of Tyana*, *Lives of the Sophists*, and *Imagines* reconceive in different ways Greek religion, philosophy, and art in and for the world of the Roman Empire. In this volume, *Heroicus* and *Gymnasticus*, two works of equal creativity and sophistication, together with two brief *Discourses* (*Dialexeis*), complete the Loeb edition of his writings. *Heroicus* is a conversation in a vineyard amid ruins of the Protesilaus shrine (opposite Troy on the Hellespont), between a wise and devout vinedresser and an initially skeptical Phoenician sailor, about the beauty, continuing powers, and worship of the Homeric heroes. With information from his local hero, the vinedresser reveals unknown stories of the Trojan campaign especially featuring Protesilaus and Palamedes, and describes complex, miraculous, and violent rituals in the cults of Achilles. *Gymnasticus* is the sole surviving ancient treatise on sports. It reshapes conventional ideas about the athletic body and expertise of the athletic trainer and also explores the history of the Olympic Games and other major Greek athletic festivals, portraying them as distinctive venues for the display of knowledge.

##### *Chopard and Zagato* Wentworth Press

A journalist who “illuminates the human drama behind the headlines” writes about today’s dramatic events, from terrorist attacks to tsunamis (Publishers Weekly). “An uncannily honest writer,” Amitav Ghosh has published firsthand accounts of pivotal world events in publications including the *New York Times*, *Granta*, and the *New Yorker* (The *New York Times Book Review*). This volume brings together the finest of these pieces, chronicling the turmoil of

our times. *Incendiary Circumstances* begins with Ghosh's arrival in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands just days after the devastation of the 2005 tsunami. When one thinks of the Mille Miglia, the most celebrated race in the world that took place between 1927 and 1957, the mind certainly goes back to OM, Bugatti,

Mercedes-Benz, Porsche, Lancia as well, of course, as the ultra-victorious Alfa Romeo and Ferrari, the greatest car manufacturers that have competed in the Italian marathon. But the memorable history of the great race is made up mainly of men: drivers, co-drivers, mechanics, technical and sports directors, organisers as well as film and show business personalities plus, naturally, an immense public following. All of those faces have names, some well-known others less so, and stories, some well worth telling others less so. The book brings together a series of portraits in alphabetical order that make up the fragments of this historic sports and cultural mosaic that was the Mille Miglia, once again told by Leonardo Acerbi from his deep knowledge of the Brescia-based race.

### **Il Puledro di Castagneto** Ember

The new, official book of the 2015 Mille Miglia opens with a focus on the memorable victory in the 1955 event by Stirling Moss and Denis Jenkinson in a Mercedes-Benz 300 SLR. They won the Brescian classic at an incredible average speed of 157 kph (97.6 mph), a record that has remained unbeaten. And three of those Silvers Arrows dominated the 2015 commemorative Mille Miglia, opening the roads of northern Italy for the crews that had brought their extraordinary cars to the event, which touched, as always, a number of the most delightful cities and locations in the bel paese. This year's race was dominated by the Bugattis, with the French-built cars taking the first 10 places overall as well as in that Temple of Speed, the Monza Autodrome. The 2015 Mille Miglia's visit to one of the world's fastest racing circuits was its homage to Milan, home of the world-famous Expo, to which the central part

of the book is devoted and which concludes as in previous years with a systematic cataloging of all 438 starters. Yet another record for a race that retains unaltered its unequalled fascination. As always, numerous professional racing drivers were at the start of the race, including Sir Stirling Moss, Hans Herrmann and Ralf Schumacher, each driving one of the works Mercedes-Benz 300 SLRs and they were joined by Jochen Mass, Cesare Fiorio, Derek Bell and Karl Windlinger.

Un vero peccato, perché questo piccolo uomo che nel 1938 corse la Mille Miglia a piedi per pubblicizzare la XII edizione di una competizione che si stava rinnovando e per fare un favore all' amico Renzo Castagneto, meritava giustizia. Poco meno di due mesi gli sono serviti per correre gli oltre 1.600 chilometri del percorso che, al suo arrivo, anche le vetture avrebbero percorso, ma in poco più di dodici ore. Seggioli tenne fede al suo intento e durante il lungo peregrinare per l'italico stivale, scrisse un diario nel quale raccolse episodi al limite del fantastico dei quali fu protagonista. Uomo poco avvezzo al lavoro, viveva di espedienti ed ebbe una lunghissima carriera militare, non solo

con la divisa italiana. Nato ad Agnosine, in Val Sabbia, morì nel 1970 e venne sepolto nel Cimitero Vantiniano di una Brescia che lo aveva dimenticato, tra nobili e personaggi importanti, non per meriti ma perché vi aveva ricoperto il ruolo di fossore. Un'impresa, quella del Puledro di Castagneto che andava raccontata, perché è parte della Mille Miglia che, anche per aneddoti come questo, rimane la Corsa più bella del Mondo.
