The Years of Alienation in Italy Associazione culturale Nilalienum Frutto di un lungo lavoro clinico e teorico, imponente per dimensioni, struttura, articolazione, bibliografia, apparato concettuale, ricco di "casi", prezioso per l'approfondita conoscenza che l'Autore si è formato di quello che propone come il discorso anoressico – mentre per la medicina l'"anoressia nervosa", come del resto tutto ciò che è classificato "malattia mentale", è un fuori-discorso, e tendenzialmente un disturbo da eliminare –, questo libro, che non evita il confronto con gli studi specialistici in materia, pone le fondamenta di una clinica psicanalitica dell'anoressia dove la direzione della cura è determinata dal linguaggio e dagli snodi del "significante", o più esattamente, della lettera. Al contempo, anche l'elaborazione teorica procede attraverso lo stile raffinato e "letterario" di una scrittura implicata nella decifrazione di ciò che è sorprendentemente in gioco nel discorso anoressico: «un nuovo nodo sociale, fondato su un'etica irragionevole, insensata e alternativa». La "cura analitica" si fa così, freudianamente, "lavoro di civiltà". Non manca tuttavia un'aspirazione didattica a trasmettere, anche ricorrendo all'utilizzo (non sussidiario) di numerosi schemi, quanto viene strappato all'enigma dell'anoressia.

Horace G. Danner's A Thesaurus of English Word Roots is a compendium of the most-used word roots of the English language. As Timothy B. Noone notes in his foreword: "Dr. Danner's book allows you not only to build up your passive English vocabulary, resulting in word recognition knowledge, but also gives you the rudiments for developing your active English vocabulary, making it possible to infer the meaning of words with which you are not yet acquainted. Your knowledge can now expand and will do so exponentially as your awareness of the

roots in English words and your corresponding ability to decode unfamiliar words grows apace. This is the beginning of a fine mental linguistic library: so enjoy!" In A Thesaurus of English Word Roots, all word roots are listed alphabetically, along with the Greek or Latin words from which they derive, together with the roots' original meanings. If the current meaning of an individual root differs from the original meaning, that is listed in a separate column. In the examples column, the words which contain the root are then listed, starting with their prefixes, for example, dysacusia, hyperacusia. These root-starting terms then are followed by terms where the root falls behind the word, e.g., acouesthesia and acoumeter. These words are followed by words where the root falls in the middle or the end, as in such terms as bradyacusia and odyacusis.. In this manner, A Thesaurus of English Word Roots places the word in as many word families as there are elements in the word. This work will interest linguists and philologists and anyone interested in the etymological aspects of English language.

The refreshed insights into early-imperial Roman historiography this book offers are linked to a recent discovery. In the spring of 2014, the binders of the archive of Robert Marichal were dusted off by the ERC funded project PLATINUM (ERC-StG 2014 n°636983) in response to Tiziano Dorandi's recollections of a series of unpublished notes on Latin texts on papyrus. Among these was an in-progress edition of the Latin rolls from Herculaneum, together with Marichal's intuition that one of them had to be ascribed to a certain 'Annaeus Seneca'. PLATINUM followed the unpublished intuition by Robert Marichal as one path of investigation in its own research and work. Working on the Latin P.Herc. 1067 led to confirm Marichal's intuitions and to go

beyond it: P.Herc. 1067 is the only extant direct witness to Seneca the Elder's *Historiae*. Bringing a new and important chapter of Latin literature arise out of a charred papyrus is significant. The present volume is made up of two complementary sections, each of which contains seven contributions. They are in close dialogue with each other, as looking at the same literary matter from several points of view yields undeniable advantages and represents an innovative and fruitful step in Latin literary criticism. These two sections express the two different but interlinked axes along which the contributions were developed. On one side, the focus is on the starting point of the debate, namely the discovery of the papyrus roll transmitting the *Historiae* of Seneca the Elder and how such a discovery can be integrated with prior knowledge about this historiographical work. First published in 1891, Pellegrino Artusi's *La scienza in cucina e l'arte di mangiar bene* has come to be recognized as the most significant Italian cookbook of modern times. It was reprinted thirteen times and had sold more than 52,000 copies in the years before Artusi's death in 1910, with the number of recipes growing from 475 to 790. And while this figure has not changed, the book has consistently remained in print. Although Artusi was himself of the upper classes and it was doubtful he had ever touched a kitchen utensil or lit a fire under a pot, he wrote the book not for

professional chefs, as was the nineteenth-century custom, but for middle-class family cooks: housewives and their domestic helpers. His tone is that of a friendly advisor – humorous and nonchalant. He indulges in witty anecdotes about many of the recipes, describing his experiences and the historical relevance of particular dishes. Artusi's masterpiece is not merely a popular cookbook; it is a landmark work in Italian culture. This English edition (first published by Marsilio Publishers in 1997) features a delightful introduction by Luigi Ballerini that traces the fascinating history of the book and explains its importance in the context of Italian history and politics. The illustrations are by the noted Italian artist Giuliano Della Casa.

Star Male di Testa (SMT) è un compendio divulgativo sulle esperienze di disagio psichico, frutto di una vita di studi e di pratica terapeutica critica. La moderna psichiatria, restaurando una rigida barriera tra normalità e anormalità sulla base dell'assenza o della presenza di sintomi, fa un duplice torto: alla normalità, perché impedisce ad essa di prendere atto del suo statuto precario e in parte mistificato, e all'anormalità, perché toglie ad essa qualunque significato che non sia riconducibile ad una primaria disfunzione del cervello. L'ipotesi organicistica è stata avanzata, senza prova alcuna, dagli psichiatri dell'Ottocento. Gli eredi attuali – i neopsichiatri – sostengono che essa sia stata confermata dai recenti sviluppi delle neuroscienze.

Si tratta di un'impostura. L'avversione alla psichiatria organicistica da parte dell'autore è nata con la scelta stessa di dedicarsi ai problemi della salute e del disagio mentale. Ricostruendo la storia sociale, familiare e interiore dei singoli soggetti e fornendo un'interpretazione psicodinamica di gran parte dei sintomi, dei vissuti e dei comportamenti che essi sperimentano, il saggio ne illumina il significato radicalmente umano, univocamente riconducibile al conflitto tra due logiche: la logica dell'appartenenza (le "ragioni" degli altri) e la logica dell'individuazione (le "ragioni" dell'io). In questa nuova ottica, le esperienze di disagio psichico hanno sempre un significato potenzialmente evolutivo. Il loro trasformarsi in "malattie" dipende dal fatto che, per motivi soggettivi, sociali e spesso legati all'intervento psichiatrico, tali potenzialità non trovano modo di dispiegarsi.
